The Family Version is designed for use by children with diabetes and their families. It provides basic diabetes education to children, their parents, siblings, and other family members.

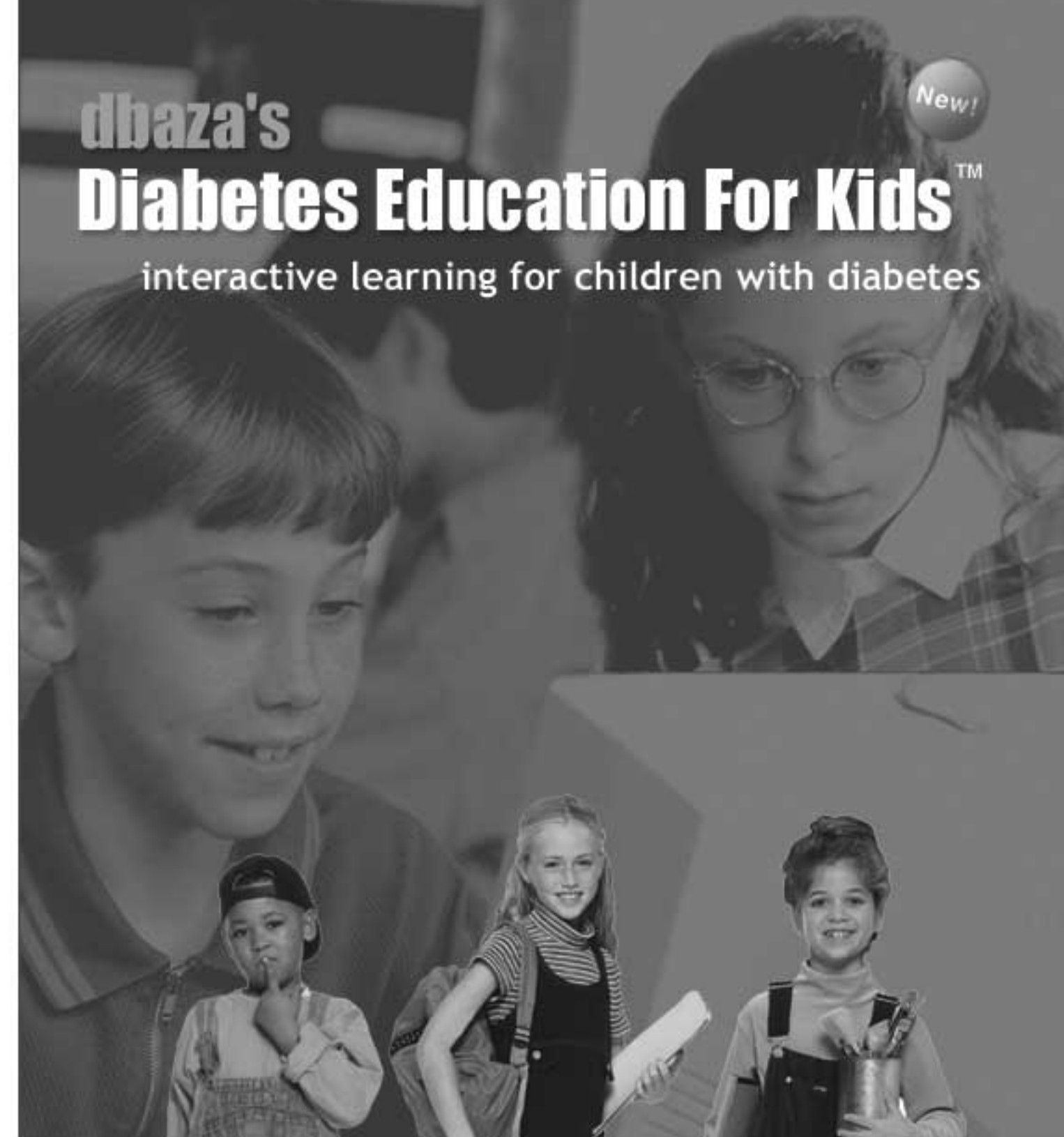
